OVERSEAS PATIENTS

- If you are registering for the first time in the UK please note that we will need to see your passport. This should be handed in along with your registration forms so that we may obtain a copy for our records.
- Any students should also provide course information, which includes a start and finish date.
- Overseas patients who are working in Scotland should provide evidence such as: A Contract of Employment/Letter from Employer, Visa/Permit, Proof of Residence, Letter from the Home Office/ UK Border Agency. If self employed, please provide a letter from Accountant/Solicitor or company invoices.
- Visas/Permits – Overseas visitors may also have appropriate UKBA (UK Border Agency) documentation to show that they are entitled to work, study or get married in the UK. Forms IS96 for asylum seekers, ARC or SAL.
